PHOTOGRAPHY. People intending to take photographs at these events must register with the Tournament Organiser beforehand, please request a Registration Form.

G.N.A.S. & F.I.T.A. RULES apply to these World and British Record Status Tournaments. All archers competing, to wear the accepted form of dress.... Registered Club Colours or plain dark green, and /or white, otherwise they will be asked not to participate.

No archer may take more than one prize or challenge trophy offered by the North Wales Archery Society in either competition; best golds, worst white, excepted.

EQUIPMENT INSPECTION Saturday - 8.00 a.m. onwards at the Judges Tent.

ORDER OF SHOOTING - F.I.T.A. STAR - 30 minutes (3.19.1.1) of practice in timed ends will commence at 8.45 a.m. on archers own boss. All arrow holes to be marked as faces will not be changed before start of competition. The two long distances 90 & 70 m men and 70 & 60 m ladies will be shot in ends of 6 arrows in 4 minutes. 50 & 30 m distances will be shot in ends of 3 arrows in 2 minutes. There will be 4 archers per boss shooting in 2 details.

VISUALLY IMPAIRED archers are welcome shooting the appropriate Burntwood Rounds.

DRUG TESTING: Record Status Shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply; if they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. A juniors parent or guardian must sign the reverse of the entry form to signify their consent to a junior being tested if required.

CARAVANS and CAMPING There is room on the ground for Caravan parking and tents. A licensed bar, meals and snacks are also available. Please keep to the track when driving around the ground to park caravans otherwise this facility will be withdrawn. Access will be controlled during shooting. Pets are not allowed onto the ground.
